He is the author of Thinkers Keys, The Ripple Effect, Mindlinks, Wrapped In Living and a series of manuals and workbooks that stimulate innovative thinking in classrooms. His latest book 'The Next Generation' was released by Wiley and Sons publishers in late 2017.

Tony has twice appeared recently on national TV, and in numerous radio interviews and feature articles in newspapers and magazines.

He is an ambassador for School Aid Australia, a non-profit organisation that has raised over \$5 million in the past ten years to support children in disaster-affected regions of the world.
